

On the weekend of Aug. 23-24, Fr. Benedict Mwangi will speak at all Masses on behalf of his Diocese of Murang'a in Kenya for this year's Mission-Co-op Appeal.

The purpose of this appeal is to raise essential financial support for the Diocese of Murang'a, which is currently experiencing severe economic hardship. Your generosity will directly benefit the following critical needs:

- —Providing food, education, and financial assistance to 60 orphans
- —Covering the cost of medicine and hospital care for 100 children and 30 adults living with HIV at our two diocesan hospitals
- —Supporting the formation and education of 86 major seminarians preparing for the priesthood.

The Diocese of Murang'a, located in East Africa, spans 4,019 square kilometers and comprises 55 parishes served by 130 diocesan priests and 13 missionary priests.

The Diocese is blessed with 12 religious congregations, including a newly-established women's congregation.

In addition to two hospitals, the Diocese operates one missionary hospital, 14 dispensaries, several primary and secondary schools, two schools for the deaf, and three special education institutions across two major districts.

A second collection will be taken during on the weekend of August 23-24 at all Masses to support this year's Mission Appeal.

Bishop's Appeal Update: Thus far the Parish has raised \$16,394 towards our goal of \$21,900.

The Bishop's Ministries Appeal supports the ministries that go out into the parishes – faith formation and evangelization, CYO sports, formation of seminarians, care of the retired priests, and meeting the unexpected needs of schools and parishes. The second collection for Bishop's Appeal is on the weekend of August 16-17. Thank you for your contributions to the Bishop's Appeal.

To dig, I am not able: to beg, I am ashamed. I know what I will do, that when I shall be put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses. Therefore calling together every one of his lord's debtors, he said to the first: How much dost thou owe my lord? But he said: A hundred barrels of oil. And he said to him: Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. Then he said to another: And how much dost thou owe? Who said: A hundred quarters of wheat. He said to him: Take thy bill, and write eighty. And the lord commended the unjust steward, for as much as he had done wisely: for the children of this world are wiser in their generation than the children of light. And I say to you: Make unto you friends of the mammon of iniquity, that when you shall fail, they may receive you into everlasting dwellings.

PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

VERE dignum et justum est, æquum et salutáre, nos tibi semper et ubique grátias ágere, Dómine sancte, Pater omnípotens, ætérne Deus: Qui cum unigénito Fílio tuo, et Spíritu Sancto, unus es Deus, unus es Dóminus: non in unius singularitáte persónæ, sed in unius Trinitáte substántiæ. Quod enim de tua glória, revelánte te, crédimus, hoc de Fílio tuo, hoc de Spiritu Sancto, sine differéntia discretiónis sentímus. Ut in confessióne veræ, sempiternæque Deitátis, et in persónis propríetas et in esséntia únitas, et in majestáte adorétur æquálitas. Quam laudant Angelí, atque Archángeli, Chérubim quoque ac Séraphim: qui non cessant clamáre quotidíe, una voce dicéntes:

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to Thee, holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son and the Holy Ghost, art one God, one Lord: not in the Oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what by Thy revelation we believe of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation; so that in confessing the true and eternal Godhead, in It we should adore distinction in persons, unity in Essence, and equality in Majesty: in praise of which Angels and Archangels, Cherubim also and Seraphim day and night exclaim, without end and with one voice saying:
